#### ORGANIZATION

NAFTO is an educational and professional association concerned with apprenticeship training (commonly referred to as the Field Training Officer concept) for police, communications and corrections personnel. Educators, administrators, and other criminal justice practitioners are encouraged to participate. The concept of NAFTAO was formalized with its incorporation as a non-profit organization in California in 1991 and was reorganized/relocated to a more central location (Colorado) in 1993.

State chapters have been formed in California, Wisconsin, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Wyoming, and Washington. Chapters are also in the process of being formed in Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Oklahoma and New Mexico.

- To conduct training seminars and conferences in FTO program related issues.
